



## PAVING NOTICE LETTER

Dear Resident:

Marshall Township has contracted with Shields Asphalt Paving, Inc., via the public bid process, to provide road resurfacing services for the 2019 season. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this process as there may be some delays and inconveniences. Please travel with caution to protect yourself, your vehicle, and our workers. During the road resurfacing process, there will be manholes, water valves, and inlets that will be exposed and marked with cones and/or bright neon paint. Please use caution until the final asphalt has been placed.

Road paving work (weather conditions permitting) is **tentatively** scheduled to begin **Wednesday July 17<sup>th</sup>** and should end by **Friday August 2<sup>nd</sup>**.

At that time, **NO STREET PARKING** will be permitted from **6 AM to 7 PM**. Please have your vehicle removed prior to the start of working hours or they will be towed at the owner's expense. Additionally, roads will be open to residential traffic only during this time.

**Roads in your area included in the road resurfacing program: Woodhurst Ter, Strawberry Ln, Blueberry Ln**

To prevent unnecessary damage to your property or a delay with this project, we are asking you to mark the location of all lawn sprinkler heads and lines along with drain lines and/or pipe outlets located on your property that flow towards the road prior to the start date noted above. Electric dog fences placed in the Right Of Way should be marked as well. Neither the contractor nor the Township will be responsible for any damages to these items.

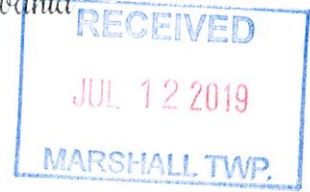
The road resurfacing process will include:

1. Milling, power brooming and cleaning of the road surface. Since the curb may be removed during this process you should take caution in exiting your driveway both before and after the temporary ramps are installed.
2. Spraying of a tack coat onto the road surface followed by the application of asphalt. The tack coat material can be very slippery to drive on and it may splash onto your vehicle and even track into your driveway. All efforts will be made to minimize this situation while at the same time maintaining traffic flow during this project.

During the construction process, if a member of our crew asks you to wait prior to driving on the roadway, it is in your best interest to follow our instructions to avoid damages to your vehicle or the new asphalt. After paving has been completed, please do not park on the curb for 30 days as it may cause damage.
