Planning Commission Position Open

Have you ever wanted to get involved with Marshall Township, to see what is happening in the Township firsthand, or to volunteer your time for the betterment of Marshall Township? Volunteers throughout Marshall Township enhance the quality of life for all of our residents by sharing their time and talents. Below, is a listing of all open positions:

Planning Commission: There is one open position on the Marshall Township Planning Commission (PC). The PC is a seven-member panel appointed by the Marshall Township Board of Supervisors. The term of office for a Planning Commission member is four years and members must be residents of the Township.

In Marshall Township, the PC meets monthly, generally the first Tuesday of the month, and responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and making recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on proposed subdivisions, land developments and conditional use applications;
- Preparing and/or making a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors on amendments to the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances; and
- Participate in the update(s) of the Marshall Township Comprehensive Plan and make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors regarding adoption of the plan.

Residents interested in a position on the PC would benefit from having familiarity with the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, the ability to read plans and technical drawings, understand of the development process, surveying, engineering and/or landscape architecture.

The Board of Supervisors will schedule interviews after review of the submitted letters of interest.
