Sealed Proposals will be received by Marshall Township, Allegheny County, PA for the Marshall Township Altmeyer Park Improvements as follows:

The bid involves (but not limited to) construction of parking lot, sidewalk, site lighting, landscaping, grading and other items as indicated within the construction documents.

All proposals must be addressed and in the hands of the Township Manager, Julie Bastianini, Marshall Township, 525 Pleasant Hill Road, Wexford, PA 15090 before 2:00 p.m. prevailing time on Friday, March 1, 2019 and the same will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words "ALTMYER PARK IMPROVEMENTS".

Pennsylvania prevailing wages shall be paid on this project.

Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Municipality of Marshall Township in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal.

All proposals will remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of opening.

The Marshall Township Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or any part thereof for any reason and reserves the right to waive any informality therein or to award the bid to the best responsible bidder.
